

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

OD CARPETS

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INSTRUCTIONS FOR MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING OF: BRAIDS, RUGS AND POUFS IN PP

TO PREVENT SURFACE DEGRADATION, FREQUENT VACUUMING OR BRUSHING TO REMOVE DUST IS RECOMMENDED. MOST SURFACE STAINS OR DIRT CAN BE REMOVED IF READILY TREATED. AIR-DRY. BRUSHING WITH AGGRESSIVE SYSTEMS (FOR EXAMPLE: ABRASIVE SPONGES, ALUMINIUM STRAW, BRUSHES MADE OF TOO RIGID MATERIALS OR METAL) CAN SERIOUSLY DAMAGE THE SURFACE CAUSING RUPTURE OF MICROFILAMENTS AND LOSS OF COLORED MICROFILAMENTS AS WELL AS TRIGGERING UNCONTROLLABLE OXIDATIVE PHENOMENA. ALWAYS ROLL ALONG THE SIDE OF THE SEAMS. DO NOT DRAG THE CARPET TO AVOID DAMAGING THE SEAMS. DURING PERIODS OF NON-USE IT IS RECOMMENDED TO STORE THE CARPET IN A DRY AND COVERED ENVIRONMENT.

REMOVAL OF STAINS

NON-GREASY STAINS:

CLEAN WITH A CUP OF HOT WATER WITH HALF A SPOON OF REGULAR DETERGENT. GENTLY DAB THE STAIN WITH A CLOTH OR SPONGE MOISTENED WITH THIS SOLUTION , WORKING FROM THE INSIDE TO THE OUTSIDE OF THE STAIN. DON'T RUB. ONCE THE DIRT IS REMOVED, SPRINKLE THE AREA WITH CLEAN WATER TO REMOVE ANY TRACES OF DUST. DON'T USE STAIN REMOVERS. IF A CHLORINE-RICH DETERGENT IS USED, RINSE WITH PLENTY OF CLEAN WATER AND DO NOT LET IT DRY IN DIRECT SUNLIGHT.

GREASE OR OIL STAINS:

BUTTER, OIL, LIPSTICK AND THE LIKE MUST BE REMOVED WITH ACETONE. ONCE THE DIRT IS REMOVED, APPLY A DETERGENT SOLUTION TO THE CARPET AND RINSE WITH CLEAN WATER, FOLLOWING EXACTLY THE SAME PROCEDURE AS FOR SOLUBLE STAINS. (SEE MAINTENANCE). TO AVOID DIRT DEPOSITS, IT IS RECOMMENDED TO VACUUM FREQUENTLY OR BRUSH GENTLY TO REMOVE DUST. MOST OF THE DIRT AND STAINS CAN BE CLEANED IF TREATED PROMPTLY
