Rotation function (360°) and individual back adjustment




Filigree base frame, metal, powder-coated fine structure in black matt




Quality outdoor solid wood in different wood variants




Alignment of base plate:







Screw in the adjustable foot flush-mounted from above with the supplied allen key.

Attention! The adjustable foot must not unscrewed downwards!


Rust protection measure, thread: Should rust form on the threads of the adjustable foot after some time in the outdoor area, please wipe it off with a cloth and a drop of oil. Bullfrog also recommends that the thread be kept in good working order with a drop of oil once a year.




Use of back function:

Adjustment of back slant:

1. To adjust the desired position grip the back from the outside and pull it carefully into your direction.



- 2. To obtain zero position pull the back carefully beyond the top position into your direction and fold down into zero position.
- 3. From zero position you can easily snap the back into desired position.
